- Toys for children

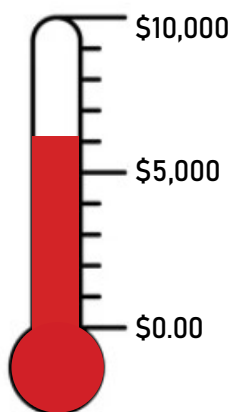


All of our St Vinnie's members will represent each of you as we will deliver these generous gifts on your behalf.
