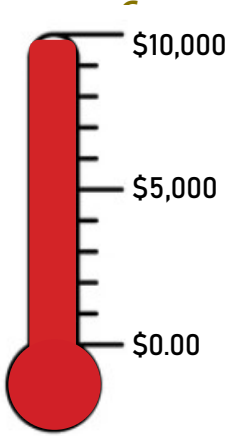

Jn 18:33b-37
